# Tender Notice No.1/2017/SPD Dated: 07.03.2017

Sealed Tenders are invited for the supply of Tubular Batteries for UPS of computers for [Hard Rubber Container (Ordinary), Plastic container and Sealed Maintenance Free (SMF)] batteries for a period of one year from the date of the final acceptance of the tender as specified in the schedule given below, required by the various Government Departments/PSU's/Local Self Government Institutions/Autonomous Bodies etc, on Rate Contract basis at any of the offices within the regions mentioned therein and when required by Government.

 For the purpose of concluding Rate Contract, the 14 Revenue Districts in the State are classified into three regions as follows;

Regions Districts

1 Southern Region Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Alappuzha and Pathanamthitta

2 Central Region Kottayam, Idukki, Ernakulam, Thrissur and Palakkad

3 Northern Region Malappuram, Kozhikkode, Kannur, Wayanad and Kasargod

- 3). The rate for each item in each region shall be submitted separately and the same tenderers may quote for one or more or all the three regions for all items ie, Hard Rubber Container, Plastic container and Sealed Maintenance Free (SMF) battery. The Rate Contract Holders should supply all the items of Tubular Batteries at the respective District Head quarters in the Region.
- 4) Sale of Tender forms will be closed at 2 pm on 24.03.17. Tenders should be superscribed as "Tender No. 1/2017/SPD dated 07/03/17 for supply of Tubular Batteries/ Hard Rubber Container/Plastic Container/Sealed Maintenance Free (SMF) for the UPS of computers Southern/Central/Northern Region" which should be addressed to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Stores Purchase Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala State-695001 so as to reach his office not later than 3 PM on 15.04.17 Belated tenders will not be accepted. The tenders will be opened at 2.30 PM on 18.04.17 in the office of the Additional Chief Secretary or the officer authorized for the purpose in the presence of such tenderers or their authorized representatives present at the time. If the dates is/are declared as holiday by Government by any unexpected reasons, the sale, acceptance and opening of Tenders will be done at the same time on the next working day. Tender forms are not transferable.
- 5) Each tender should be accompanied by the Specification Chart, Booklet of the original manufacturers, warranty period (warranty at least 1 year from the date of delivery). The successful tenderers selected should furnish a Test Certificate for the battery of every specification at their own cost recently obtained within one year from among one of the following Government/Public Sector Institutions (1) Council of Science and Industrial Research Lab (CSIR) (2) Electronic Regional Research Testing Lab (ERTL) (3) Central Institute of Road Transport (CIRT) Pune (4) Chief Electrical Inspectorate, Thiruvananthapuram (5) Central Power Research Institute (CPRI), Bangalore (6) National Institute of Technology (NIT), Kozhikkode. Test Certificate from the institutions not mentioned above will not be accepted. The Tenderers need not submit the Test Certificate along with the Tender Form. Preference will be given to the items having ISI Certification. The supplier should clearly specify the life period/guarantee period (at least one year from the date of supply) of the batteries which they got tested. Intending tenderers should quote a single rate inclusive of all taxes, transportation, loading and unloading charges etc. and all other expenses for the supply of that item on Regional basis. Tenderers should quote the rate for charged and uncharged batteries separately. If the rate is quoted for the uncharged batteries, initial

filling charge will also be quoted separately. The rates of scrap batteries also to be quoted. The rates will be valid for acceptance till 15.08.17 for all districts in the regions as indicated in para 2 above. The Stores Purchase Department reserves the right to reject any tender without assigning any reason or for awarding the Rate Contract for all the regions to the same tenderer or only one or more regions at a time based on the usual terms and conditions. The Department will also have the right to accept or reject the rate quoted for any of the item in a tender. After opening tenders, the lowest tenderer should produce the samples in the Stores Purchase Department before awarding Rate Contract for testing the batteries when called for. The tenderer should furnish an EMD of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) each for each item of Hard Rubber Container/Plastic Container and Sealed Maintenance Free Battery separately for each region either in cash remittance in Stores Purchase Department or crossed Demand Draft from a Nationalized Bank in favour of Additional Chief Secretary, Stores Purchase Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram payable at Thiruvananthapuram.

6) Intending tenders may submit an application to the Additional Chief Secretary, Stores Purchase Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala State - 695001 to obtain the requisite tender form along with a cash remittance of Rs.1,900/- + VAT at the existing rate to Stores Purchase Department which will not be refunded at any circumstance. The cost of Tender forms should be paid by money order or cash. The tender forms are not transferable. Sale of tender forms will be closed at 3 PM on 15.04.2017 The cost of Tender Forms should be paid by money order or in cash. Postage and Court Fee Stamps, etc will not be accepted towards the cost of tender form. Duplicate forms will be issued at Rs. 1,000 + VAT per copy. Those who wish to get the tender forms by post should sent postal charges of Rs. 50/- (for Registered post) in addition to the cost of documents. Government will not be held responsible for postal delay, if any, in the delivery of the documents or receipt of the same. Further details relating to the tender will be supplied along with the tender forms. Tender details will also be available from Government Website www.spd.kerala.gov.in.

#### SPECIAL CONDITIONS

 The period within which the goods should be supplied: The supplies should be made within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the supply order from the consignee. If the tenderer is a Distributor / Agent he should produce the letter of Authority from the Manufacturer.

 Delivery: The price quoted should be for free delivery by goods train in any of the Railway Stations in Kerala State as the consignees may stipulate. The supplier

should supply batteries in all District Head Quarters also.

 Warranty: The period of warranty and period of warranty replacement should be stated. Warranty/life period of the battery (minimum one year from the date of supply) should be clearly specified.

4. Nature of services: The nature of Service Warranty should be mentioned.

5. The rates are to be firm upto 15/08/2017 for acceptance by Government.

 Specification: It may be stated that whether the batteries bear ISI Mark/ Specification and if so, specify the number.

7. Payment: Payment will be made within two weeks from date of delivery of goods

in good condition.

 Agreement: Every tender should be accompanied by a preliminary agreement as stipulated in the Tender form.

Every page of the Tender form should be authenticated by the Tenderer. Otherwise Tenderers will be rejected.

### OTHER CONDITIONS

 The contract will be a Rate Contract valid for a period of one year from the date of award. The supply is to be made as and when required during the period of the contract.

Full details should be mentioned in all cases indicating whether the tenderer is small scale or large scale industrial unit. Attested copies of

certificate should be produced with the Tender.

3. Preference will be given to batteries with ISI Mark subject to the condition that the rates are reasonably acceptable. Successful tenderers selected for the supply should produce test certificate from any one of the following institutions, for each specifications selected from the Council of Science and Industrial Research Lab or Electronic Regional Research Testing Lab, Central Institute of Road Transport (Pune), Central Power Research Institute, Banglore, NIT, Kozhikode or Chief Electrical Inspectorate, Thiruvananthapuram obtained recently (within one year) as and when required by Government. Offers without ISI Mark Certificate from any of the above institutions will be rejected.

4. (a) The price quoted should be basic rate and rate inclusive of all taxes, duties, transportation charges, cesses, loading and unloading etc which are or may become payable by the contractor under the existing or future laws of rules of the country of origin/supply or delivery during the course of execution of the contract. The details of scrap battery should be specified in the tender. The normal period specified for delivery of the battery will be one week, in any case, not later than two weeks from the

date of supply order.

- (b) The prices of scrap batteries to be accepted should be quoted for each variety of battery and not so many rupees per kilograms of weight and also specify whether the value of scrap quoted is for monolid or multilid or plastic case.
- 5. Ordinarily, payments will be made only after the supplies are actually verified and taken to stock and within two weeks from the date of delivery and in exceptional cases payments against satisfactory shipping documents including certificates of insurance will be made upto 75% of the value of the material at the discretion of Government. Bank charge incurred in connection with payment against documents through Bank will be to the account of the contractor.
- 6. All offers should be from indigenous sources and they must confirm to the specification shown in the Tender schedule. No offer on import license basis will be accepted in the ordinary course. If any import licenses are required, it should be mentioned in the tender itself.
- 7. The exemption usually given to SSI units/ Public Sector Undertakings and Registered Dealers borne on the Stores Purchase Department from furnishing Earnest Money Deposit will not be given in this case. This is a Rate Contract. Tenders without Earnest Money Deposit will be rejected.
- 8. The successful tenderer will have to execute an agreement in the prescribed form within the time required by Government after furnishing the required Security Deposit. The amount of Security due from each firm will be intimated after finalization of Contract.
- Every tenderer should send along with this tender an EMD @ Rs.1,000/- for each item of Tubular Batteries (Hard rubber container, Plastic Container and Sealed Maintenance Free separately) for the UPS of Computers, for each voltage/capacity, in cash or Crossed Bank Drafts from Nationalised Banks.
